So what happens?

Start with breakfast at one of our top Clubhouses followed by a full safety brief. Then proceed to the ranges for your event package picked from the following disciplines.



Shotgun

Trap

Clays are launched at varying angles from traps mounted in trenches below the layouts

Skeet

Clays are launched from towers and move across the firers line of vision

Down the Line

Clays come from a trap and move in a straight line away from the firer

Return to the Clubhouse for a delicious lunch followed by afternoon tea and prizegiving at the end of the day.



Rifle and Pistol

Black Powder Pistol

Replicas of American Civil War revolvers fired at up to 20 yards

Gallery Rifle

Pistol calibre rifle fired from a standing position at static targets

Timed Firing

.22" bolt action rifle fired from a standing position with rapid fire



Need more of a challenge?

Sniper Rifle

Rifles with telescopic sights fired at pop up targets

Sporting Rifle

Rifles with telescopic sights fired at moving targets

Target Rifle

7.62 mm target rifles fired at distances from 300 to 1000 yards



What do I need to bring with me?

All events, except target rifle, are held under cover but it is suggested that you bring waterproof outdoor clothing.

All shooting is under one-to-one supervision and all training and equipment is provided.

Breakfast, lunch, tea and light refreshments are included.

Do I need any previous experience?

No previous experience is needed and it is not unusual for complete beginners to end up with the day's top score! Shooting is suitable for all age groups and is one of the few sports where men and women compete on equal terms. Bisley is also fully equipped to cater for disabled participants.
